The Committee consists of up to eight (8) representatives from the First Nations communities of the Nlaka'pamux, and Secwepemc Nations and Upper Nicola Band.

The Committee meets quarterly or more frequently, as needed. The successful candidate will need to complete an Oath of Confidentiality and have a letter of support or Band Council Resolution from their community.

The HRS Steering Committee will make determinations for new Members based on a criteria matrix to ensure diverse representation of First Nations communities, housing experience and knowledge, skills, and commitment to further the goals of the HRS.
